Program accepted waste: this program accepts any brand of used plastic bread bag closures, including EcoLok bread bag closures.

Important notes

- This program does not accept other forms of bag closures such as twist ties and tape.
- Please remove any labels from bag closures before sending to TerraCycle, as this contaminates the waste stream.

What happens to the Waste?

Once collected, the bread closures are cleaned and melted into hard plastic that can be remoulded to make new recycled products.
