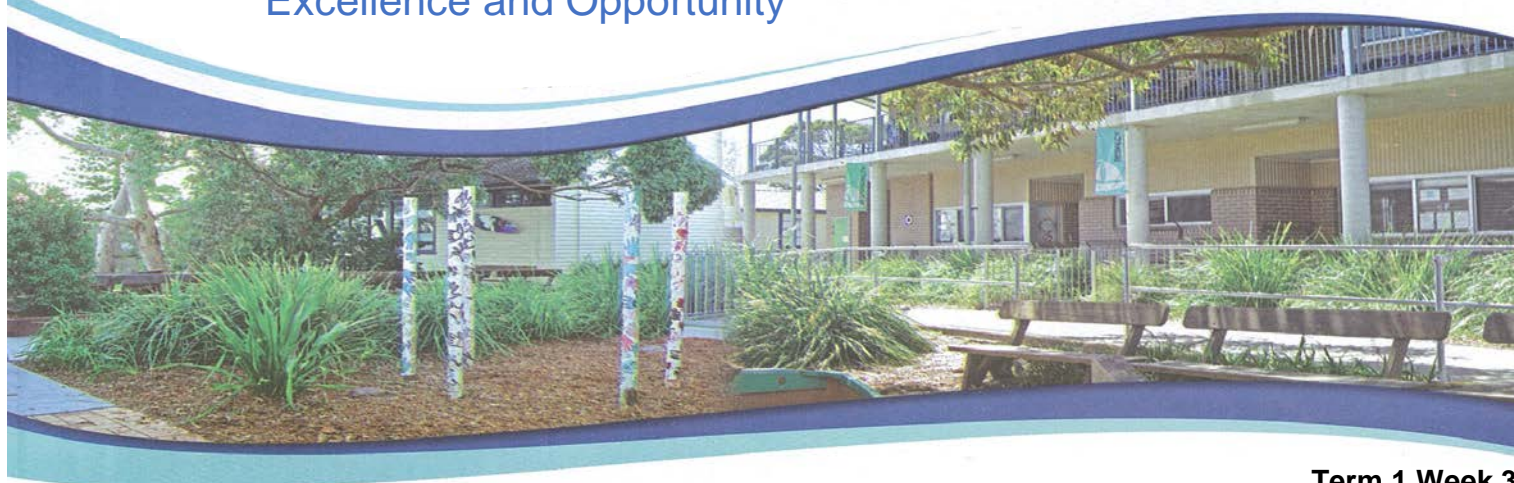

### Year 5 'Get to Know You Day'

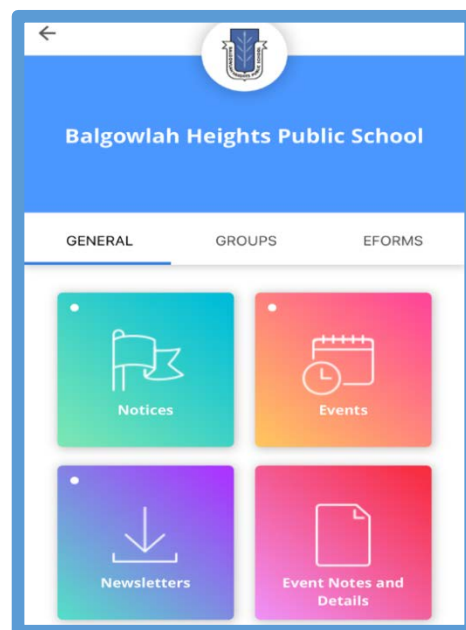

## **THE FOREST HIGH SCHOOL – GATS TEST, OPEN NIGHT & MEET THE PRINCIPAL DATES**

The Forest High School will be holding our **GATS (General Achievement) Test** on the following date:

**Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March from 9.00am to 11.30am**

Testing will take place in the school hall. If you are unable to attend on this date a reserve session will also be held on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March from 4.00pm to 6.30pm**

Students wishing to be placed in our Gifted and Talented class for Year 7 2020 must first sit for this test. The Year 7 G&T class for Year 7 2020 will be determined after close examination of the test results and the students' NAPLAN results from Year 5. The cost of the test is \$40.00, payable on the day in cash only. Students are to bring a 2B or B pencil, an eraser and a ruler. No calculators or dictionaries can be used.

The test consists of three parts:

Part 1 – Mathematics – 40 multiple-choice questions

Part 2 – Reading and Language – 40 multiple-choice questions

Part 3 – One writing task

Students are requested to arrive at The Forest High School **by 8.45am for a 9.00am start** or **by 3.45pm for a 4.00pm start**. They are also requested to bring a copy of their NAPLAN results on the day of the test. **If you would like your child to sit for this test please ring The Forest High School on 9451 5111 to register. Please register by Friday 1st March.**

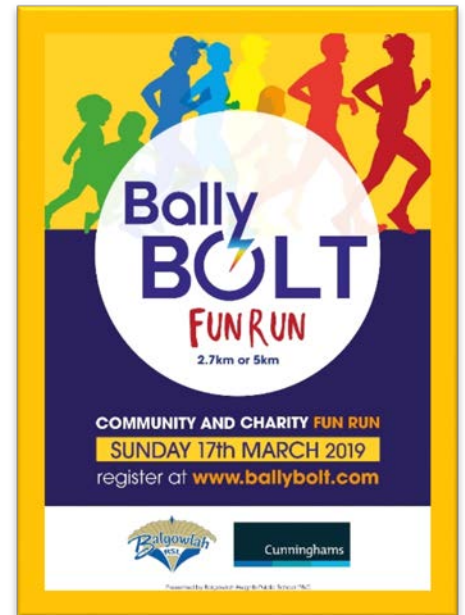

### Is your child absent from Arabanoo? - Please let us know

Please let us know if your child isn't going to attend Arabanoo. This can be done via our My Family Lounge App, by email or phone (details below).

### How to use the My Family Lounge App -

Download from the App Store (Green Splodge) and login into the App.

Marking your child as absent -

1. Click on Casual Booking (even if it's a permanent booking)
2. Click on your child's booked day on the calendar (blue)
3. Check the details of the day
4. Press Mark Absent
5. A pop-up will display advising the day has been successfully marked as absent
6. Press OK
7. The selected day will change from booked (blue) to absent (yellow)

The centre will receive a notification of this absence. No further communication is required. Once you have finished using the app click on the menu top right of screen select Sign Out
