Did you know that the DoE's Healthy Canteen Strategy stipulates that 75% of food available in the canteen be "everyday food" and 25% be "occasional food"? They will still be available for you to order for your child on Flexischools, but they will not be sold direct to the students over the counter at recess or lunch. We will offer the students alternative, healthier cookies, fresh baked muffins and other delights.

We will also be introducing a 'rewards card' for students who purchase a healthy snack. They will receive a special treat after 10 purchases of our specially marked snacks!

- Confirmation: If you haven't received a confirmation email regarding your summer booking, please contact us.
- Opening hours: 7.30am 6pm
- **Pick up and drop off**: Please ensure you have given us contact details for any new authorised persons picking up or dropping off your child. Failing to do this will mean a delay in pick up or drop off of your child. If a new authorised person is picking up your child, please ensure they bring along photographic ID.
- **Departure Times**: The bus departure times are on the 'What's On Form' (download from <a href="www.arabanoo.com">www.arabanoo.com</a>). On days we go on an excursion please make sure to drop your child off at least half hour before the stated departure time.
- · What to bring:
  - Broad brimmed/bucket hat (no caps) We have hats for hire for \$5 per day
  - Enclosed shoes (no sandals, open toe shoes, crocks or thongs)
  - Warm clothing (Some excursions are outside and there are lots of outdoor incursions as well)
  - Activity appropriate clothing (Swimmers)
  - Morning tea and lunch (avoid nuts)
  - Refillable water bottle
  - Medication if required (please make sure it's labelled with the child's name and hand it to a staff member when dropping your child off)
