





### Junior Pick Up - Parking on Lewis Street

As most of you will be aware we split the Juniors and the Seniors every afternoon apart from Fridays and during inclement weather when all children are on the senior campus (Western). With the new fences in place the access gates on the Radio Avenue entrances will be locked, so please access the Junior Campus (Eastern) via the Lewis Street gates when picking up your children. If you have children on both campuses unfortunately we dont always have a spare educator to bring your children over to you, so please allow extra time when picking up.

### **Notification of Absence - Use our App**

If your child is sick, going on a play date or not attending Arabanoo for other reasons please make sure to let us know. You can mark your child absent on the My Family Lounge app (preferred option) or email/phone the Arabanoo office. Please note that we are separate from the school and that the school office doesnt notify us if your child isnt at school. 
