


Why not get creative and make a list of kind acts you could do with your child/children for World Kindness Day and beyond. Together let's make kindness the norm at BHPS and in our community.

Returned goods will only be accepted in resale condition: unworn, unwashed, unmarked with tags attached in **original intact packaging**. There are **no returns** or **exchanges** on Hats, Recorders, Hair Accessories, socks/hosiery and Second-Hand items.

**Size Exchanges** can be made via the Administration Office, just **attach a note** with the size to swap to and your child's Name & Class. eg "Can I exchange this size 4 for a size 6 please" and it will be available for pick up at the next Uniform Shop desk time.
