
### **Sports Equipment Collection**

RePlay is a not-for-profit charity that delivers pre-loved sporting equipment and sports shoes to children and young adults in disadvantaged communities: Northern Territory, Tonga and Africa. They accept equipment related to all sports, including but not limited to rugby union, AFL, NRL, soccer, athletics, gymnastics, tennis, hockey, netball, basketball, baseball, cricket, golf and swimming. Shoes must be without holes and the soles must be secure / not falling apart. They must also be clean, free of dirt with the laces tied together in pairs.






**Peer Support at BHPS** has been buzzing with excitement as our K-6 students continue to learn from their Year 6 leaders. It has been a great learning experience for everyone!

Last week, the focus was on step 2 of the model, Plan. The children learnt about developing a range of coping strategies and to be creative in drawing on these when planning responses. Responses include persevering, seeing the positive side to situations and engaging in activities they enjoy as a distraction for a short time. Please continue to encourage your child to talk with you about strategies they could use as difficulties arise.

Tomorrow, the students will be participating in their seventh session, Resilience: Moving Forward which focuses on step 3 of the Pause, Plan and Proceed Model (see diagram below). BHPS students further develop the range of strategies they can use in challenging situations. The session will focus on step 3 of the model, Proceed. In order to learn from situations and move forward children need to go beyond thinking of strategies and action them. Children recognise despite the use of a range of strategies, sometimes they cannot change the situation. At these times, it is important to accept the situation and move forward with a positive outlook. It is important to then help your child evaluate if this has worked or if they need to try a different strategy.





It has been a privilege watching our Year 6 students develop their leadership and communication skills as they deliver Peer Support to our K-6 students. We look forward to our final session of Peer Support in Week 10.




#### Kiss & Drop safety flyer
