

MATHEMATICS

Warm up - Let's revise counting to 100. Using the Big Number Song.

Addition - Roll and Flip Game



Watch the video by Miss Saltmarsh showing you how to play Roll and Flip. You will need some playing cards and a dice for this activity. Have your cards out on the table or on the floor. Roll the dice onto the cards. Where the dice land on is the dice and card combination you need to add together. For example 7 and 5 makes 12. Record your addition sums on a piece of paper.
